Competitive Events Eligibility

- **All first, second, third and fourth place winners in all events**, except Creed (not an NLC event), LifeSmarts and the Virtual Business Challenge (separate qualification process).
- **Members can compete in only one individual/team event and one chapter event.** Chapter events are American Enterprise Project, Community Service Project, Local Chapter Annual Business Report and Partnership with Business Project.
- **Middle level members (grades 6-8) are not eligible to compete.**

NLC Registration Process

- Chapter advisers register students for NLC, and CA FBLA registers students in their competitive event.
- **NLC registration will be \$65 for students and \$0 for advisers.** Please register for the conference at <https://fbla-nlc.org/fbla-fbla-ml-registration/>.
- Meet with students who are interested in competing at NLC. Check <https://fbla-nlc.org/fbla-competitive-events/> for the competitive events schedule and event modifications. **Check the "timeline" section to make sure students can compete on the assigned date. Live performances may start as early as 8 a.m. Pacific.**

Complete your NLC interest spreadsheet by Friday, May 7 at 5 p.m.

- **Find the tab in the spreadsheet with your chapter name.**
 - This tab contains all your chapter's top-10 SLC winners, as announced at the Awards of Excellence program.
 - This spreadsheet is sorted in alphabetical order by event, then by place.
- **Complete the "NLC Yes/No" column for each top-10 placement.**
 - **Saying "Yes" for a 5th-10th place winner does not guarantee that student will compete at NLC**, but if CA FBLA has the information, it makes it much easier to "bump up" students and notify advisers of students who are now eligible to compete at NLC.
 - **Members can compete in only one individual/team event and one chapter event.** Chapter events are American Enterprise Project, Community Service Project, Local Chapter Annual Business Report and Partnership with Business Project.
- **Complete any acceptable substitutions by saying "REMOVE FirstName LastName, ADD FirstName LastName."**

- **Spreadsheets are due to Nancy Sansot (nsansot@cafbla.org) and Manuel Rapada (mrapada@cafbla.org) by Friday, May 7 at 5 p.m.** Only advisers can submit spreadsheets.
 - Before submitting, please make sure any students who placed top-4 in multiple events have said **"yes" to only one individual/team event and one chapter event.**
 - Any cells that are blank will be considered a "No" for NLC.

Review your registration and submit prejudged materials by Wednesday, May 12 at 5 p.m.
